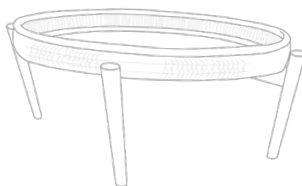
Allen key for central fitting. This is provided.

RATTAN, BAMBOO & ACACIA WOOD with MIRRORED GLASS

Each piece has been individually handcrafted to create a unique piece of furniture.

PROPERTIES OF RATTAN & BAMBOO

Rattan & Bamboo are natural materials and variations in shape, colour and finish may occur.

PROPERTIES OF ACACIA WOOD

Acacia wood is a hardwood timber. Acacia wood is coarse in texture and its colour varies from light to dark brown. Natural variation may occur adding charm to each piece.

MIRRORED GLASS

Safety backed but handle with care and avoid any sudden impacts.

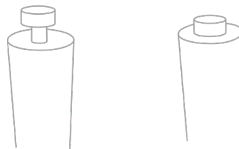
CARING FOR YOUR FURNITURE

Wood, bamboo and rattan are natural material.

During warm, humid weather wood can expand. During dry weather wood contracts. These seasonal variations are a normal characteristic of wood.

To help maintain the natural beauty and performance of your piece of furniture do not position in front of radiators, avoid direct heat, direct sunlight, moist environments, or outdoor use.

Table legs have adjustable levellers for perfect stability.



WARNING!

Any spills should be removed immediately. Never let them dry out on the surface.

To maintain the appearance of your wooden furniture, we suggest regular dusting with a soft cloth. Always use a coaster to protect the glass surface.

Do not use abrasive cleaners as these may damage the surface.

Not suitable for children's rooms or bathrooms.

Do not sit or stand on the table.

Take care when moving the furniture.

Do not drag furniture as it may cause damage to the joints.

Please note, the above are guidelines only.

Periodically check fittings as they may come loose over time.
